  - Catalpa Oaks (Southfield)
  - Highland Oaks (Highland Twp.)
  - Independence Oaks (Clarkston)
  - Orion Oaks (Orion Twp.)
  - Lyon Oaks (Wixom)
  - Rose Oaks (Holly)
  - Waterford Oaks (Waterford)
  - No Preference

Oakland County Parks agrees to:

- Purchase and properly label the geocache container.
- Provide logbook and pencil for geocache.
- Place the cache at the park indicated according to OCPR geocaching guidelines.
- Maintain the cache for the length of one year after which time this agreement will be revisited and the cache is either removed permanently or relocated to another location.
- Provide your organization with the coordinates of your geocache.
- Provide a final report of your cache activity at the end of the year, including posted and hand-written logs.
- E-mail cache updates throughout the life of your cache as requested.

\_\_\_\_\_ agrees to work with Oakland County Parks in the planning of the geocache and will reach a mutually satisfactory decision on issues of concern. Both parties have read the above Outline of Agreement and understand what is required.
